- Jade’s Hip Hop Academy in Brampton helps children grow through dance by providing an inclusive and supportive space to learn, and helping families who may not have otherwise had the means to participate.

The *Keep Moving™* program is just one of the ways 407 ETR supports its surrounding communities. In 2022, the Company completed its \$4 million multi-year donation to the United Way to help provide COVID-19 relief for food and income security, mental health services, and support for isolated seniors in the GTA.
